RECOGNIZE: Recognize when you may have encountered a munition and that munitions are dangerous.

RETREAT: Do not approach, touch, move or disturb it, but carefully leave the area the way you entered.

REPORT: Call (804)633-8224 or (804)633-8911! Immediately notify local law enforcement of what you saw and where you saw it.

TYPE OF FISH	DAILY CREEL LIMIT	LENGTH LIMIT
Largemouth Bass	5	No Bass 15 inches or longer may be harvested
Crappie	25	NONE
Bluegill (bream) and other sunfish excluding crappie	50	NONE
Channel Catfish	5	NONE
Chain Pickerel	5	NONE
Grass Carp	ALL MUST BE RELEASED	N/A

How Hard will you Hit the Ground?

You Choose . . .
(Ex. 180 lb. hunter falling at 32.1 ft/s² striking the ground)

Fall Height	Impact Force
30 ft. @ 30 mph (1.37 sec)	20,597 lbs. (10.3 tons)
20 ft. @ 24.5 mph (1.12 sec)	13,731 lbs. (6.9 tons)
16 ft. @ 21.9 mph (1 sec)	10,983 lbs. (5.5 tons)
12 ft. @ 18.4 mph (0.8 sec)	8,237 lbs. (4.1 tons)
